



WHAT IS HOBY?

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Program Requirements

- Must stay on-site for entire length of the conference
 - There are exemptions for late arrival and early pickup needs.
- Registration must be paid and all pre-conference materials and required security deposits completed prior to arriving
- Come with open mind



Ambassadors

- 170+ attending from 115 schools
- 40 staff with over 18 adults
- Divided into 13 groups of 12-14 with this year's theme.
- Will be with groups most of the conference






Program Overview

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Program Overview

- From 8am till 10pm each day they will be actively involved in all facets of Leadership.
 - Guest speakers
 - Group activities they will be in groups of 12 for most of the conference
 - Curriculum challenges.
- As a result of this.....
 - From wake up to lights out they will be instructed to not use their phones unless part of an exercise.





Lodging

- Ambassadors will be in JCU dorms (2 to a room, some singles)
 - Rooms have AC
 - Rooms have sinks
 - Showers are centralized on floors by wings
 - Ambassadors can bring snacks and food/drinks for rooms
 - Ambassadors will not be back into their rooms each day till lights out (with exception of dorm dashes to change)
 - Suite upgrades are available (3 or 4 person suites)
 - Roommate assignments are random

 - Separate sleeping quarters, shared private bath/shower

Packing List

- Notebook and Writing Instruments
- Bed linens sheets (single/twin size XL), blankets or sleeping bag
- Pillow and Pillow Case
- Bath Towels and Wash Cloths
- Shower Shoes
- Toiletries shampoo, deodorant, toothbrush, toothpaste, personal care products, etc.
- Hair dryer, curlers, etc
- Clothing
 - Casual, comfortable clothing shirts, shorts (halfway-ish to knee length), jeans/long pants, etc.
 - Nice dress attire for Sundays Closing Ceremonies and Dinner
 - Ladies skirts, blouses, dresses or dress pants, etc
 - Men dress pants and shirt (Vest, jacket, tie optional)
 - Sweatshirt or other long sleeve shirts
 - Sturdy walking shoes (must have close-toed shoes for Service Projects)
 - Set of Clothes you don't mind getting dirty for Service Project
 - Mulching, Painting, and other projects may be part of the program
 - Outfit for Talent Show
- Umbrella and/or rain coat
- Sunscreen
- Alarm clock
- Small fan (rooms are air conditioned)
- Small amount of spending money \$35-50 (optional for HOBY merchandise and other items available during the weekend)
- Reusable water bottle
- Snacks / Drinks They can have them in their rooms, and pack light snacks to carry with them thru the day if so desired, but cannot snack during presentations or guest speakers.
- OTC medicines (Ibuprofen, allergy pills, etc...)

"Talent" Show




HOBY Ohio North is bringing back the "Talent" Show
